Acts 27:1

And when it was decided...

Acts 27:2-3

So, entering a ship...

“Care” = “To Refresh”

Acts 2:42 (NKJV) And they continued steadfastly in the apostles’ doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.

Acts 27:4-6

When we had put to sea...

Psalm 90:17 (NKJV) And let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us, And establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.

Verses 7-12 Dangerous Sailing...

Acts 27:7-8

When we had sailed slowly...

Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV) For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Acts 27:9-10

Now when much time had been spent...

Paul advised them...

“Perceive” = “To perceive from past experience”

Acts 27:11-12

Nevertheless the centurion...

Exodus 32:1 (NKJV) Now when the people saw that Moses delayed coming down from the mountain, the people gathered together to Aaron, and said to him, “Come, make us gods that shall go before

us; for as for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.”

Numbers 14:10 (NKJV) And all the congregation said to stone them with stones. Now the glory of the Lord appeared in the tabernacle of meeting before all the children of Israel.

“Tempestuous” = “Hurricane or Typhoon”

“Euroclydon” = “A Violent Agitation”
